

INCREASE IN SEWER RATES

The City's sewer rates will increase by 6.4% beginning with the July 2014 statements. The bi-monthly sewer base rate will go from \$21.55 to \$22.93, and the amount paid for sewer system usage will increase from \$2.80 to \$2.98 per 1,000 gallons of water used. Sewer only customers will see their bi-monthly bill increase from \$61.68 to \$65.63. Water rates will remain the same at a bi-monthly base charge of \$9.75 and the amount paid for water usage will remain at \$1.50 per 1,000 gallons of water used.
