There has been a decided increase in scams lately. Some residents have reported getting fraudulent letters from SHA concerning past due accounts. While it is true that SHA and our law firm, KSN, have been sending collection letters to homeowners who are in arrears, we have also discovered that

we have been hacked. At least one homeowner has been tricked into sending funds to a fraudulent account. As much as the Board sympathizes with the homeowners who have been scammed, legally we are not allowed to forgive any debts owed to the Association.

If you receive any letters notifying you of past due accounts please check your records for evidence of payments, then contact the Clubhouse either in person or by calling 630-393-3033. Remember, if you have received a fraudulent letter, the telephone number and e-mail address will also be false.

If you have been contacted by SHA about past due assessments or are aware that you have or will miss a payment, please contact the Clubhouse Office as soon as possible. It is in your best interest to reach out as soon as possible to SHA to address any past due accounts.

When you are speaking to any of our personnel, either in person or on the phone, please be respectful. Our office staff can check your account but, please remember, that payment agreements must be approved by the Board. Also, no arrangements for forgiveness or discounts will be made and any fees from our legal firm are the homeowner's responsibility and cannot be waived, rescinded, or discounted.

The bridge over Continental Drive needs work. We have been able to do some things in-house but as it continues to deteriorate and building codes change, the Board has come to the realization that the work will need to be done at least in part by outside contractors. We have been getting assessments of and bids for the needed work and frankly it is higher priced than we had expected. At this point we are looking at three possibilities: make the needed repairs and improvements, then continue with maintenance; remove and replace the bridge; demolish the bridge altogether.

Before any major changes are made the Board would like input from the SHA residents. Please contact the Board either online, with a note sent to or left at the Clubhouse, or by coming to a meeting. The next Board meeting will be Thursday, April 10th at 6:00 p.m. and the next Architectural and Maintenance meeting will be Thursday, April 24th at 7:00 p.m. Homeowners are always welcome at either.

Brush Pickup Starts April 7th Preparing a Pile for Pickup

Please observe the following guidelines to ensure staff safety and an efficient pickup.

If your brush pile does not comply with these guidelines, it will not be picked up.

BRUSH COLLECTION GUIDELINES

3 feet high

- All brush must be bundled securely with twine, no wire.
- Bundles must not exceed 50 pounds.
- Put out pile prior to 7:00 A.M. on the day of pickup.
- Limit to one pile of trimmed brush per address.
- No logs, lumber, yard waste, thorns, or root-balls.
- Pile size cannot exceed the following dimensions: 3 feet high, 8 feet wide, and 15 feet long.
- Branches do NOT exceed 8 inches in diameter.
- Branches do NOT exceed 8 feet in length.
- All brush under 2 feet long is considered yard waste and should be placed in yard waste bags with a yard waste sticker to be picked up by the City's contracted garbage company on your designated garbage day.
- Place cut ends extended toward the street. If piles are not prepared with all cut ends toward the road, the pile will not be picked up.
- Brush placed in plastic bags or other containers will not be picked up by the City.
- If the brush does not comply with these guidelines, you will be given a notice, and the pile will not be picked up.
- Once the pile complies with the guidelines, contact the Public Works Department and the pile will be picked up.
